

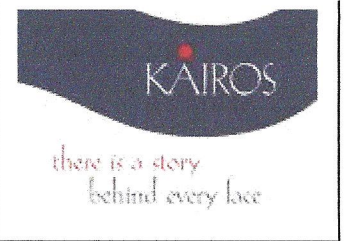

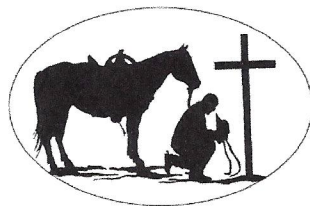

Their purpose is to facilitate growth and maintenance of Kairos ministries within the state. The State Chapter Committee elects a representative to the Kairos International Board of Directors. It is the responsibility of the representative to keep the state committee informed of the policies and procedures of the Kairos Board. The State Chapter Committee is a servant group, which directs and supports the work of volunteers engaged in the mission of the Kairos ministry. The Committee meets quarterly.*
